Security calls Manager about a broken external door lock at the hotel's Fitness Center. Manager two-ways the Maintenance department to make the replacement of the door lock a high-priority repair.

Bellhop receives a transferred guest call to pick-up some luggage from their room, just one floor above where the Bellhop currently is assisting other guests.

DuraFon systems are designed and built for rugged and demanding environments in a ISO9001 factory. Designed to take on the rigors of hotel and motel properties from guest rooms and loading docks to pool area and grounds. DuraFon handsets are drop-tested 54 times on to concrete from over 6 feet. To pass the drop-test DuraFon must work 100% and only user replaceable parts may separate from the handset (eg: battery cover).
